Applicants must submit a 500 to 750 word, typed essay based on the prompt:

The Scholarship Committee encourages applicants to discuss the topic with the Union Members in their lives to learn what Union Membership has meant to them.

The Scholarship Committee will review and rate each essay; the top 5 rated essays will be selected. Personal specifics such as names, local numbers, and Cities/Towns will be redacted when presented to the committee for rating, to ensure complete impartiality.

The decision of the Committee is final.
